A WORD FROM Fr. Ryan

The overall message from this weekend's Gospel: Don't let evil defeat you! Drown evil with an abundance of good! This complements what was written in last week's bulletin: We should strive for Heaven and avoid Hell. As long as we stay close to Jesus in prayer and in the Eucharist at Mass, we have absolutely nothing to fear! When Jesus ascended into Heaven, He still left us Himself. We have the Lord in the Eucharist and in each other.

In the Church, we will find our path to holiness, happiness, and ultimately, Heaven. In the Church, we always have hope.

Once again, I'd like to remind you that we, as a Church, are celebrating a great Jubilee of Hope in 2025. As Christians, we are always people of Hope. If we cling to Jesus Christ in His Church, we have the comfort of God's presence and the strength to move forward in life with a supernatural outlook and supernatural hope.

As Christians, we also have the privilege of charitably assisting our brothers and sisters in need. We can help others sustain their hope. A lot of people are struggling in our city. This year's *Annual Catholic Appeal* is an opportunity for us, as a parish, to help the Archdiocese provide for the needs of our brothers and sisters in Christ. 24% of what is raised by our parish will stay within our parish. 26% of what is raised will benefit low-income parishes and schools in the Archdiocese. Another 41% will support initiatives of the Archdiocese to form priests, provide scholarships for Catholic education, and renew the prayer life of our Archdiocese and parishes. The last 9% raised will help offset the cost of the Appeal.

Together, we bring hope. By contributing to the *Annual Catholic Appeal* you can make safe the way for others to find holiness, happiness, and ultimately, Heaven. We can defeat the evil of sorrow with the great good of hope!

Appeal envelopes are at all entrances to the Church. They will be collected in a second collection at all Masses this weekend and next. I say it all the time, something special is going on here. Soon, we'll be back to where we once were. Mass attendance is up and our collections are almost at the point where we financially break even monthly.

The *Annual Catholic Appeal*, though, is an extraordinary opportunity to help others while helping ourselves. It's worth supporting with gusto for the good of our local Church and the good of our parish. This is an opportunity for us, as a parish, to say that "We're Back! And Our Hearts Are Bigger Than Ever!"

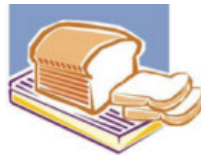
March 5th Services

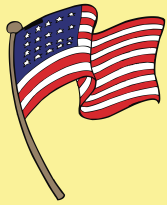
St. Christina Parish Domestic Violence Outreach

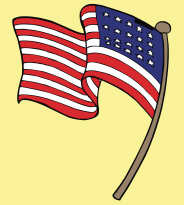

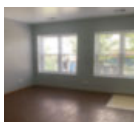
