A WORD FROM Fr. Ryan

As we gather around the altar of our beautiful Church, please remember my promise to pray for you from afar! I carry your intentions with me and remember them at each Mass.

I am currently staying with the Sisters of the *Order of the Most Holy Savior*. They are more commonly known as the Sisters of St. Bridget of Sweden. They have beautiful black and gray habits with a white crown marked with five red spots, reminding them of the five wounds Jesus suffered during His Passion.

The *Casa di Santa Brigida*, in which I'm staying, was built in the 14th Century — the building in which I'm staying is over 700 years old! I have stayed with the Sisters of St. Bridget many times and I feel right at home. They are lovely! St. Bridget of Sweden and her daughter St. Catherine of Sweden both lived and founded their religious order here.

During the 20th Century St. Elizabeth Hasselblad re-founded the *Order of the Most Holy Savior* and lived in the convent. During World War II and the Nazi occupation of Rome, St. Elizabeth Hasselblad hid (and saved the life of) over 60 Jews in the private quarters of the convent.

Casa di Santa Brigida holds a very special place in my heart. This is my eighth visit with the Briggittine Sisters. I've spent a lot of time here. But



from the very beginning, the Sisters have made it feel like home. Please enjoy the few photos of the *Casa* and my friend Mother Gertrude.

The Briggittine Sisters have two houses in the United States. One is in Darien, Connecticut and the other in Columbus, Ohio. Please pray for an increase of vocations to the Sisters of St. Bridget. They are truly holy and wonderful women.



In the Gospel this weekend, we encounter the second Mystery of Light of the Holy Rosary. Our Lady discovered a terrible problem! The booze ran out at a wedding (GASP!) and she knew her Son could help. Jesus said, "My hour has not yet come." And Mary changed God's plan and brought forward "the hour." That's the power of Mary's intercession.

The miracle happened because Mary interceded. The miracle happened through Jesus' power. But also through Mary's directive: "Do whatever he tells you." When Jesus asked to fill jars with water, there weren't complaints. The waiters didn't need water, they needed wine! But they obeyed to perfection. That's how miracles happen. St. Augustine would say, "pray as if everything depends on God. Act as if everything depends on you." Jesus asks us to do our part. And He transforms what little we can do, into an abundance!

May we too pray well and work hard to grow in holiness. May we look to Mary, our mother, and hear her voice: "Do whatever He tells you."

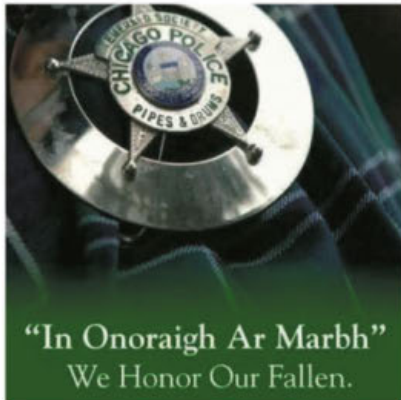

The Angelus, *Explained*

The incarnation of Christ changed the life of every Christian person who ever lived. Reflecting on that moment in salvation history is an opportunity for grace, growth and peace. Who wouldn't want that every day, or even three times every day?

The Angelus is composed of three antiphons which narrate the annunciation, each followed by the recitation of a Hail Mary (a prayer that itself contains the "angelic greeting" of the angel Gabriel). Its name is derived from the first words of the prayer in Latin.

This devotion was developed over the course of several centuries and is rooted in the ancient practice of saying three Hail Marys in the evening. Historically, people were called to prayer by the ringing of church bells — "the Angelus bells." Most people who recite the Angelus do so daily at noon, though it is often said in the morning, at noon and in the evening.

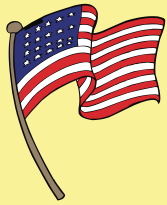
St. Christina Parish Domestic Violence Outreach

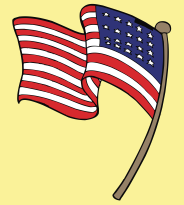
