A WORD FROM Fr. Ryan

Amazingly, the season of Lent begins this coming Wednesday. Are you prepared?!

I do not know about you, but a temptation I face every Lent is to refuse to go into the desert with Jesus. Very often, I think just giving up snacking or listening to music in the car is simply enough for a good Lent. It's simply not true. When I do so little, and nothing more, I end up the same man on Easter Sunday that I was on Ash Wednesday.

For Christians, Lent is a time for "great change." Lent is not simply a time for white-knuckling 40 days without Diet Coke or chocolate. The first big hurdle to having a better Lent is to hear Christ's voice from the desert saying, "Come away to a deserted place all by yourselves and rest a while" (Mk 6:31). Let's hear those words for our Lord. And let's respond.

Every Lent, the same Holy Spirit who drove Jesus into the desert wants to drive us into the desert. The Holy Spirit wants to drive us to a still, quiet place in order to renew and deepen our relationship with God. While God is not calling us to physically to go out into the desert, God IS calling us to remove ourselves from the distractions of life. And, in doing so, we can hear Him and see Him more clearly.

That means we need to carve out more time deliberately for prayer. It also means less TV, radio, gaming, news, and even reading. I can hear it now! "But I didn't give up TV for Lent!" You don't have to. But try and be deliberate. Try and step back from the loud, noisy, and frankly, distracting things of this world for 40 days. Spend some time in silence with Jesus this Lent.

When we look to Lent, we should see Jesus in the desert. We should look to Jesus with admiration and try to mimic Him. If we are struggling, Jesus will be at our side and in our heart. Keep struggling, keep growing, and keep striving. Persevere! You won't be the same person on Easter Sunday as you were on Ash Wednesday. And, that's the point!



At each of the church entrances, you'll see the *Magnificat Lenten Companion*. This booklet is an excellent resource to "go deeper" in your spiritual journey this Lent.

Also, next week, as we begin our Lenten journey, we will be introducing *Formed*. *Formed* is a subscription website that allows you to stream Catholic movies, audio books, podcasts, children's programming, Bible studies, documentaries and more. Through an anonymous donor, we have secured a subscription for every single St. Christina parishioner.

If you are seeking deeper spiritual nourishment — *Formed* will help. If you are looking for resources to teach your children (or yourself) about the Faith — *Formed* will help. Want to learn more about our Church, our History, our Tradition — *Formed* will help. Stay tuned! Next week we'll have information on how to create a login and get all the content *Formed* has to offer, free of charge, as a parishioner of St. Christina. *Formed* can and will be a great companion on your Lenten journey.

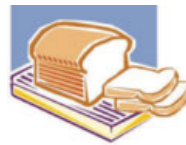

Lenten Regulations

Following are the regulations for **abstinence** and **fasting** to be observed by Catholics during Lent:

A fast and abstinence is prescribed for Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting is observed by all Catholics between 18 and 59. Those bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid food between meals is not permitted.

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years and older on all Fridays of Lent.

By the threefold discipline of fasting, almsgiving, and prayer, the Church keeps Lent from Ash Wednesday until the evening of Holy Thursday. All of the faithful and the catechumens should undertake serious practice of these three traditions. Failure to observe penitential days totally or a substantial number of such days must be considered serious.

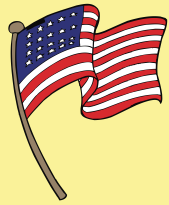
St. Christina Parish Domestic Violence Outreach



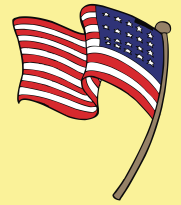
