## A WORD FROM Fr. Ryan

God loves us, broken though we are. God loves us so much that He sent his only Son to become one of us and to save the human race. His Son was born in the village of Bethlehem roughly 2,000 years ago. He grew up to become the most important person in history — Jesus of Nazareth, the Messiah, the Christ.

In His life, Jesus traveled the hills of Galilee and Judea. Jesus taught the word of God. Jesus healed the sick. Jesus gave sight to the blind. Jesus even raised the dead. In every way, He demonstrated God’s love for us and His desire to heal us spiritually as well as physically.

Jesus didn’t simply do those things a long time ago. He still does them! He still teaches. He still heals. He still performs the most incredible miracles! He still shares with us the Father’s love. With Jesus, the way to Heaven is made clear for us.

The life, death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ is the most beautiful love story ever lived. Our life with Jesus Christ can be the most beautiful love story ever lived too!

Many years ago, Francis Cardinal George wrote, “Life is not a self-directed project, but a consistent response to what is asked by those you love.” We should try to love Jesus as much as He loves us! And we should respond to what Jesus asks of us! To be a saint, it takes effort. It takes courage. It takes perseverance. But we can do it!

For this reason, as a parish, we are thinking outside of the box to bring you deeper into a relationship with Jesus Christ. We want to try and encourage you to bring the presence of God and prayer into all that you do on Sunday, *AND*, every other day!

As mentioned last week, an anonymous donor has purchased a parish subscription for every family in our parish. **This means that *Formed* is free to every single parishioner at St. Christina Parish.** Each of our 2,500 families now has access to high-quality Catholic content on their cell phone, on their computers, on their tablets, on their televisions. *Formed* offers a comprehensive collection of movies, Bible studies, documentaries, books, audiobooks, and talks. This content spans a variety of themes, including Scripture, the lives of saints, Church history, theology, and more. *Formed* also offers children’s programming to engage younger audiences in learning about our Catholic faith.

*Formed* is already used in our parish school, religious education, OCIA, and during Sacramental Preparation. I would encourage you to explore *Formed*. Use it as a family or share it with friends. This Lent, let us pray to grow in faith and deepen our understanding of God’s deep love for each of us. Put in the work. Have the courage. Persevere! We’re in this together. We can be saints!

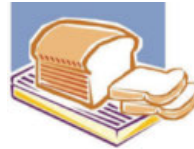

### Lenten Regulations

Following are the regulations for **abstinence** and **fasting** to be observed by Catholics during Lent:

A fast and abstinence is prescribed for Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting is observed by all Catholics between 18 and 59. Those bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid food between meals is not permitted.

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years and older on all Fridays of Lent.

By the threefold discipline of fasting, almsgiving, and prayer, the Church keeps Lent from Ash Wednesday until the evening of Holy Thursday. All of the faithful and the catechumens should undertake serious practice of these three traditions. Failure to observe penitential days totally or a substantial number of such days must be considered serious.

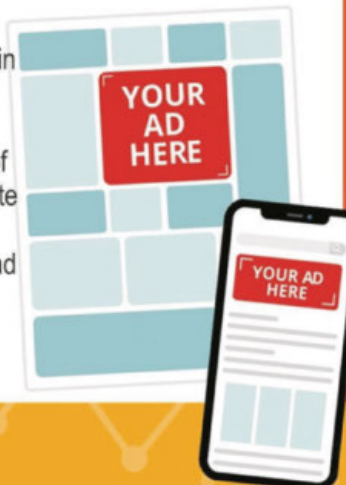

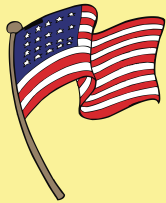
## St. Christina Parish Domestic Violence Outreach

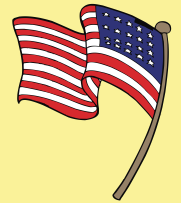
