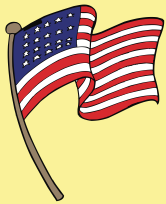
St. Christina Parish Domestic Violence Outreach

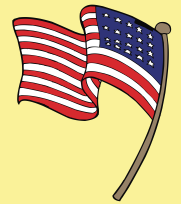
