A WORD FROM Fr. Ryan

This weekend, in the Gospel, we hear strong words from Jesus. Think of how serious a sin must be if Jesus says of the person who commits it that “it would be better for him if a great millstone were hung around his neck and he were thrown into the sea.” Jesus is referring to the sin of scandal, which, according to the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, consists of any “attitude or behavior which leads another to do evil (#2284).”

We can easily get carried away by the bad example of others! How many people excuse bad behavior because, “everyone does it!” It happens, for instance, when someone with no intention of gossiping starts chatting away with the neighborhood gossip and, next thing you know, you’re carrying on an uncharitable conversation right along with them. The same could be said of mean behavior, in addition to the mean words of gossip and slander.

But, just as bad example spreads, so does good example. A bad odor can empty a room, but a beautiful fragrance makes it attractive and inviting. May our words and actions reflect the “beautiful fragrance” of holiness and help attract people to ourselves, but more importantly, to God.



In addition to the 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time, we recognize this weekend the feast of St. Michael the Archangel. St. Michael is the Guardian of the Catholic Church. He is also the patron for police officers and military personnel. Today is a perfect day to deliberately recognize and acknowledge the brave and selfless actions of our military and first responders.

The next time you see the lights and hear the sirens of a first responder, take a moment to think about who answers those calls for help. Where are they going? What might await them? Take a moment to appreciate that these first responders, our neighbors, are putting themselves in harm’s way to keep you safe. They may not know you. They may have never seen you, never spoken to you. But they will do everything in their power to protect you. They will put your life above their own.

That’s who they are. They are the very best among us.

They are the brave men and women of the Chicago Police Department and the Chicago Fire Department. They are Ella French. They are Herbie Johnson. They are John C. Knight. They are Daniel Capuano. They are James Crowley. They are Ed Coglianesse.

And... they will always be there, fighting against violence, against brutality, against cruelty, and against anyone who wishes you harm. They will always be there, fighting for our protection and safety. They do this for you. They do it for everyone you care about.

They do it for us.

First responders... you men and women, our neighbors and friends. You are always here for us. Thank you.

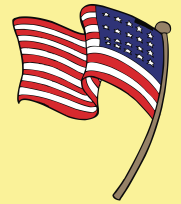
