

This weekend, we are beginning the season of Advent. This is a beautiful time of preparation for the Nativity of Jesus, our Lord and God. Jesus became present amongst us when He was born in that little town of Bethlehem roughly 2,000 years ago. Jesus has consistently been present amongst us since in the Eucharist. As we prepare for Christmas, may we live with an understanding of the presence of Jesus, our Lord and God, Who is in our midst.

The Saints live their lives consistently in the presence of God. They never forget that God is there, present in their lives. Not too long ago, while praying for golfers before a fundraising outing, I reminded the golfers that their partner may not always be watching, but God is! So, no cheating! It was a silly joke, but honestly, it's true! The saints knew that God was always with us. They strove to recognize it and grow close to Him in all they did, all the time. Saints are made when no one is watching. Saints try to behave in a saintly way "all the time."

Gaspard Cardinal Mermillod was the bishop of Geneva, Switzerland in the late 1800s. He was well known for his love for the Eucharist. Many people in Switzerland converted by simply listening to his preaching. Cardinal Mermillod used to pray before the Blessed Sacrament late every night.

Late one night he prostrated himself, as was his custom, in front of the Tabernacle. After a little while praying in silence, he heard a noise. To his great shock, a confessional door opened at the side of the church and a lady walked out. The astonished bishop asked, "What are you doing here in the middle of the night, Ma'am?!" "Your Excellency," replied the woman, a little breathless, "I'm not Catholic. But I've been listening to you preach over the last few months. I heard what you said — that Jesus is really present in that little Host on the altar. I was convinced by your arguments, but one doubt remained in my mind. I wondered if you really believed what you preach." The lady continued, "So I wanted to hide myself in the church and see if, in private, you really treated the Holy Eucharist as you said we should."

The woman believed because she saw that Cardinal Mermillod truly believed when people were watching, and when they weren't. She converted because she saw that the bishop was a man in love with the Eucharist, in public and in private: all the time. May we too fall in love with the Eucharist and, this Advent, let's try and be consistent in our Christian life. Let's be a disciple of Jesus 24/7.



This year, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception has been transferred to Monday, December 9<sup>th</sup>. We will still celebrate a festive **Mass for the Immaculate Conception on Monday, December 9<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.** Even though you are not obligated to attend Mass on December 9<sup>th</sup>, please join us honoring and showing your love for the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Thursday, December 12<sup>th</sup>, our parish will be celebrating an Advent Evening of Recollection and Confession. Beginning at 7:00 p.m., there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Adoration, a short Advent reflection, followed by the opportunity for individual confession. Fr. Rob Ryan, a dear friend and classmate of mine, will provide an inspiring Advent reflection. If you've never been to an evening like this, please come. It will be beautiful.

In the Spring of 2014, Cardinal George announced the Archdiocese of Chicago *To Teach Who Christ Is* campaign to raise money for Catholic education, faith formation, and Archdiocese parishes. Since its inception, this campaign raised over \$420 million for Archdiocesan parishes, schools, and ministries. Our former pastor, Fr. Tom Conde decided to conduct an independent parallel capital campaign, *Together We Build*, for St. Christina Parish.

Although the parish capital campaign was conducted independent of the Archdiocesan appeal – without Archdiocesan resources and assistance – the parish campaign was still subject to the Archdiocesan capital campaign assessment of 40% of total funds raised. It is my understanding that this was not communicated clearly to donors of the *Together We Build* campaign.

Since our very first days together at St. Christina, our Director of Operations, David Sullivan and I knew that clarity and finality were needed for St. Christina families regarding the *Together We Build* campaign. We have diligently examined contracts and bank statements to address your concerns, provide you with answers, and ultimately closure.

As a parish, you raised \$811,628 for the *Together We Build* capital campaign. You gave generously with high hopes and expectations. I appreciate your kindness and willingness to support our school and parish. The graph below indicates where the collected *Together We Build* monies were spent. As you can see, the funds raised were used solely on repairs and modifications to our Homan Ave. school building. Thankfully the exterior of that building is now strengthened for multiple generations of St. Christina School use.

Our Archdiocesan obligation for the *Together We Build* campaign was \$322,000. Obviously, the total campaign funds spent limited our ability to pay the required capital assessment from money raised. We have since paid \$130,000 of our obligation. By December 31, using historical savings, we will pay the outstanding balance of \$192,000.

The *To Teach Who Christ Is* campaign awarded 27,000 scholarships totaling \$150 million for at-need Archdiocese of Chicago children to receive Catholic education. \$10 million was spent on training catechists who teach our children the Faith. \$30 million was spent preserving crumbling buildings and facilities across our city that help house and feed the poor. Our Archdiocesan contribution directly helps educate, house, and feed those striving for a better future.

I want to assure you that my role as pastor is to be a good steward of your generosity. In my short time here, we have reinstituted a Finance Council to allow for financial transparency, accountability, and oversight of our spending. And, as always, you are free to reach me at the Rectory to express your concerns or ask any questions.

As we look back with clarity and finality, we can move forward with hope toward a great future. St. Christina has, and always will be, a 'powerhouse' parish on the South Side, known throughout the Archdiocese for our strength, generosity, and selflessness. St. Christina Parish has been a source of inspiration and sanctity for the people of Mt. Greenwood for nearly 100 years. And, with Jesus in our hearts, the best is yet to come!






