

We are also nearing completion of forming a Parish Council to develop a unified vision for our parish as we approach our 100th anniversary.

As we begin a new liturgical year, I can assure you things are changing. And, I don't merely mean the weather! We're looking forward to Advent and preparing ourselves for Christmas. And we're also looking forward to better practices in the way our office communicates our finances, our news, and our plans to share Jesus with you.

Being the pastor of St. Christina Parish is, and always has been, my dream job. Be careful what you wish for, as they say! It's a lot of work. And a lot of stress. But I wouldn't want to be anywhere else! Honestly, I've never been happier! In our nearly five months together, I've seen amazing things take shape. With new beginnings, come great opportunity. With God's grace, our opportunities are endless together! Being your pastor is the greatest privilege of my life. I can't wait for many more incredible moments together. Please pray for me. And be assured of my daily prayers for you.



There will be only one Mass on Thanksgiving Day — at 9:00 a.m.




Holy Name Coat Drive


