A WORD FROM Fr. Ryan

J.R.R. Tolkien, the author of *The Lord of the Rings*, once referred to God as a Great Composer. Tolkien explained that, at the beginning of time, God composed the most beautiful music. Knowing our instruments and our skills, He composed a perfect piece of music for His creatures to interpret.

The devil and many other angels decided not to follow the score and made up their own melody to increase their own glory. The incompatible noise of the devil and his minions clashed with the original composition and there was a violent war of sound.

But that didn't stop God, He is the Perfect Composer. God knows what the devil and his followers are going to play; so God has arranged new music that wraps all that noise in a more harmonious composition that was even more beautiful than before. But we are the ones God needs to play that new, beautiful music for Him.

With our Christian lives, we have to play His "symphony" the best we can.

In our work, our prayer, our service to others, even in our rest and relaxation, we should long to play that "symphony" the best we can. We should always, and in all things, long to make Jesus the King of our lives. With our Christian lives we will show that Jesus is our King.

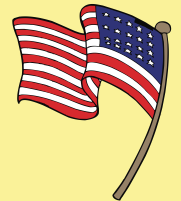
