A WORD FROM Fr. Ryan

I had an absolutely wonderful retreat! Thank you for your prayers. I also hope that you felt some grace from my prayers for you. As we begin November, I have another request for you!

November is traditionally an important month designated for praying for the Holy Souls in Purgatory. Our beloved dead are our brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus. We love them and our prayer for them is a great gift!

If you saw a boy being carried away by the current of a river and drowning, and you could save him by just stretching out your hand and grabbing him, wouldn't you help? As long as he lived, that boy would always remember what you had done for him. And you could be sure that that boy would always be happy to help you in return, any way he could.

Well, the Holy Souls in Purgatory are in a river, of sorts, right now. You can help them to get from that river to Heaven through your prayer. Like the boy in the river, struggling with the current, the Holy Souls in Purgatory can't do anything for themselves. They belong to the silent realm beyond the barrier that separates us from the other side. Yet, they are blessed, for the grace of God is with them. 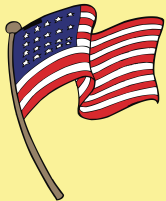
Vocation Raffle to Benefit Our Local Seminarians

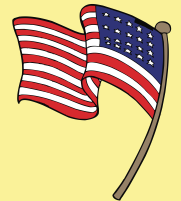
